## 3. Improving Governance & Regulation

- Implementing IORP II – Q3 2018
- Authorised Status required for all schemes
- Fitness and Probity for trustees
- “Professional” standards for trustees
- CPD for all trustees
- New Governance Codes
- New schemes must meet standards at outset – lead-in time for existing

### 3. Improving Governance & Regulation

- Develop environment for multi-employer schemes
- Improve and harmonise tax rules and number of vehicles
- Review cost of funded supplementary pensions
- Consider if ARFs can be improved
