

GETTING TO THE CCD



The CCD sits at the heart of Dublin's transport hub with excellent air, road, rail and sea connections, meaning it is only minutes from the airport, motorway network, Port Tunnel, rail stations and ferry terminals.

BY AIR

Dublin is highly accessible for delegates travelling from the UK, Europe, the US and the Middle East with airlines offering over 180 routes.

Dublin Airport is located 10km north of Dublin city centre and is just 15 minutes from The CCD via the Port Tunnel.

Dublin Bus operates a 24-hour service from the city centre to the airport. **Dublin Express** also offers a direct service to and from the airport, stopping at **Custom House**, which is a short walk from The CCD. Taxi and car hire services are also easily available.

BY FOOT

The CCD's city centre location makes it quick and easy to reach by foot from hotels or local accommodation.

BY SEA

Dublin Port is only five minutes from The CCD, and has frequent ferry services to the UK and mainland Europe for both passengers and freight, making it easy to bring in goods for use at your event. Interflow provide courier and freight services and customs clearance from any location worldwide directly to your booth at The CCD. Rosslare Harbour is located 2 hour's drive from The CCD and has regular ferry services to Wales, France and Spain.

BY BIKE

There are parking facilities in our car park, which delegates can use to secure their bikes. They are accessible by entering the East door to the building and taking the elevator to the B1 or B2 car park levels.

There are over 100 [dublinbike stations](#) distributed throughout the city centre, many of which are within close proximity to The CCD

BY RAIL

LUAS – The LUAS red tram line runs directly behind The CCD, from close to Dublin Port and serves downtown Dublin, Connolly and Heuston railway stations.

DART – The DART rail line runs through Dublin city centre and services numerous stations ten minutes' walk from The CCD.

LEAP CARD

Leap Cards are quicker and cheaper than paying for single fares with cash and they can be used to pay-as-you-go on Airlink, Dublin Bus, LUAS and DART. You can purchase them in the arrivals hall at Dublin Airport.

BY CAR

The CCD is only minutes from the Port Tunnel with connections to the upgraded M50 motorway.

PARKING AT THE CCD

There is a public car park located below The CCD with 320 spaces, 14 disabled spaces and 2 e-car spaces, managed by Euro Car Parks. The opening times are 7am to midnight, 7 days a week. Both cash and credit card payments are accepted. As this is a public car park and not operated by The CCD, we do not have the ability to provide any alerts when the car park is full.

LOST OR DAMAGED TICKETS

Press the help button on the automatic pay station machine located in each car park lobby and the operator will provide assistance.

CAR PARK ROUTES

You can enter the car park by the yellow or blue route, but you must exit by the pink route.

YELLOW Enter the car park via Mayor Street Upper (eastbound) by turning right after The CCD building and going down the ramp.

BLUE Enter the car park via Park Lane by turning left onto Mayor Street Upper (westbound), turning left again and going down the ramp.

PINK Exit the car park by turning left at the top of the ramp onto Mayor Street Upper (there is no right turn here) and at the junction with Guild Street, turn left (there is no right turn here).

Please note that there is no right turn from the Samuel Beckett Bridge onto North Wall Quay and there is no left turn from North Wall Quay onto the Samuel Beckett Bridge.
